Bloodstock South Africa Added Stakes Rules **2025 Graduates**

1. The funds raised for the added stakes program are collected from all yearlings and two-year olds sold by Thoroughbred Breeders Association of South Africa (TBA) through Bloodstock South Africa (BSA), a division of TBA. All these horses which pass through the BSA sales are eligible to compete in the added stakes program if the buyers portion has been paid in full at the time of sale. These horses can only be made eligible at the 2025 Cape Yearling Sale, National Yearling Sale, KZN Yearling Sale & August Two Year Old Sale.
2. The contributions made by the Vendors are compulsory and the contributions by the buyers are voluntary and all funds will be allocated to the added stakes program.
3. Only the first 120 eligible winners will be paid an Added Stakes bonus by BSA to the winning connections (90% Owner/s & 10% Trainer). Any winners over and above the 120, will not be eligible for the bonus. All printed advertising is printed in advance and therefore does not guarantee payment of a bonus. The BSA website shall provide updated information in respect of the number of winners and number of opportunities available in terms of the added stakes program.
4. No Bloodstock SA online sale graduates, regardless of their age, will be eligible for an Added Stakes bonus, unless the horse was previously purchased and made eligible at a qualifying sale and is still a maiden.
5. Only horses that are 2 years of age, or born in 2023, qualify for the Added Stakes bonus.
6. Horses will qualify for the Added Stakes bonus when running in open company, adhering to the abovementioned rules.
